



## **Vietnam Veterans Commemorate Vietnam Remembrance Day**

**PHOENIX, February 11, 2008 -- In-Country Vietnam Veterans, in partnership with the Vietnamese Community of Arizona and many other Veterans Organizations, will hold their 14th Annual Vietnam Remembrance Day, on Sunday, April 27, 2008, from 8:30AM to 1:00PM, ceremony at 9:00AM, at the Vietnam Memorial, Wesley Bolin Plaza by the State Capitol.**

**Reading of the annual Governor's proclamation by the event moderator Mr. Oscar Urrea, perhaps a few words by other guests, a massing of the colors, and flag raisings of the US and South Vietnamese flags by both the American and Vietnamese communities. There will be displays of historical military memorabilia, military vehicle display, and a free picnic lunch following the conclusion of ceremonies.
